Metropolitan State University invites applications for a full-time, fixed-term faculty position in the mathematics department to begin in the fall semester of 2010. This is a one-year appointment with the possibility of renewal. Responsibilities include:

- Teaching statistics courses, as well as related mathematics courses;
- Advising students including those interested in statistics careers;
- Providing assistance in curriculum development;
- Continuing scholarship and community service.

Required Qualifications:

- Ph.D. in statistics or a closely related field by the time of appointment, or a Master's degree in statistics with at least three years of related work experience in statistics;
- Demonstrated competence in teaching college-level statistics;
- Ability to teach other mathematics courses;
- Demonstrated commitment to student-centered education;
- Demonstrated commitment to and knowledge of a culturally, ethnically, and linguistically diverse student body.

Preferred Qualifications:

Candidates with one or more of the following qualifications: knowledge of biostatistics or computer programming, or experience in related fields such as numerical analysis or operations research.

Applications must be received by February 15, 2010 at 12:00 p.m. (noon) CST for an August 2010 appointment. Salary is commensurate with education and experience. Qualified applicants are required to submit:

- A cover letter outlining your qualifications and reasons for your interest in the position;
- A current vita or résumé including your areas of mathematical/statistical interest;
- One-page statement of teaching philosophy;
- Examples of teaching effectiveness (student evaluations, sample syllabi, etc.);
- ABD candidates must include a letter from their advisor including their anticipated completion date;
- Three letters of recommendation, at least one of which must address your teaching, sent directly to the search committee; and the names, addresses, email addresses, and phone numbers of two additional references.
